Day 6 – Podo Camera

The fly-on-the-wall camera.



Ever wish you could take a group photo that gets everyone in the shot and doesn't have the look of a hastily-made selfie? While selfie-sticks might get the job done, their general bulkiness and long extension arm are a nuisance to those using them and nearby bystanders.

Fortunately, [Kickstarter](https://www.kickstarter.com/projects/1212121212/podo-camera) has come up with a new and hassle-free product for selfie technology called the Podo Camera.

The Podo Camera is a miniature stick-on camera that can attach to almost any surface. The micro-adhesive sticky pad located on the back of the device is capable of attaching to a variety of solid surfaces such as a window, wall, rock, or tree.

The pad is water-proof and doesn't wear out, so it is capable of being reused.





Podo also contains 8GB of memory allowing it to hold thousands of photos and has a battery life of 2 weeks.

Taking photos with Podo requires downloading the Podo App, which is free for iOS and Android. Using Bluetooth technology, photos are captured and transferred from the app to your smartphone.

The app also allows you to adjust the angle of your photo, set a timer when taking photos, shoot videos, and can connect up to 6 individual Podos to use at one time.



The Podo Camera is currently available to buy on Kickstarter. The average cost for 1 camera is **\$49.00**. You can also buy packages of 2, 4, and 6 cameras ranging from **\$89.00** to **\$229.00**.

You are also able to buy a variety of accessories for the camera including a carrying case and extra sticky pads.

Kickstarter also offers a referral system which allows users to obtain free Podo cameras and merchandise depending on the amount of people that they refer. (ex. 5 referrals earns 1 free Podo Camera)

Podo's small size and ability to attach to any surface makes it a great device for users wanting to take selfies or group photos as the camera provides a wider frame allowing you better control over the outcome of your photos and eliminating the hassle of setting up and maintaining a selfie-stick.
